**RE: LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION FOR
DELTRAN BUILDERS COMPANY**

Dear Sir or Madam:

I am very pleased and honored to write this letter about a special undertaking between Deltran Builders and the American Cancer Society, Pennsylvania Division in 2007.

The American Cancer Society realized that, in the Philadelphia area, the need for short-term lodging and hospitality resources dedicated to patients being treated at regional cancer centers and their caregivers was undeniable. To that end, the Society's Board of Directors approved a campaign to construct and endow a Hope Lodge in Pennsylvania's southeast region.

A free residential facility, Hope Lodge provides a comfortable, nurturing environment and unprecedented access to state-of-the-art cancer care and support that greatly improves the quality of patients' lives when they are away from home for treatment. By increasing access to treatment and clinical trials and by eliminating some of the financial burdens experienced by cancer patients, Hope Lodge helps to significantly reduce disparities in cancer care, improve health outcomes, and provide a supportive community for those facing this disease.

The Philadelphia Hope Lodge provides comfortable housing designed specifically to meet the special needs of cancer patients. The Lodge has a general reception area, private rooms/suites all handicapped accessible with private baths, and a furnished sitting area. Patients have access to an equipped kitchen with individual pantry and refrigerator space, a dining room for sharing meals with other patients and their families, large comfortable furnished great rooms, laundry facilities, conference rooms, a music room, library, and exercise, game and meditation rooms. There are private living quarters for the live-in manager. These are but a few of the many unique features of a Hope Lodge facility.

For the newest 37-room Hope Lodge in Pennsylvania (the country's 27th facility), the Fox Chase Cancer Center donated the land to build this home on an adjacent campus on Laurel Road in Cheltenham, PA. The challenges were not just limited to inside needs as noted above, but outside as well – to creatively blend a large home into a wooded area next to a major health facility and to provide access for easy patient transportation. There were also numerous township restrictions along the way.



Patients' total number of nights stayed is 237 for an average total savings to our guests of \$35,550. They have built a magnificent Hope Lodge that welcomes its guests and meets their needs, fits right into the beautiful surroundings, and is warm and comfortable. The inside is bright and inviting and offers a relaxing atmosphere – a respite from cancer treatments, and a restful place where patients can make friends and find support from others. The Lodge was nicely designed to provide a classy and upscale feeling, but with warmth and comfort. Delran Builders have truly given hope an attractive home in Philadelphia and have made our dream a wonderful reality. We're extremely proud.

We are, indeed, indebted to Delran Builders for their beautiful creation in Cheltenham Township and for their commitment to the Mission of the American Cancer Society. But more importantly, it is those facing cancer who are truly benefitting from Delran's vision and labor. We just could not be more pleased with the first-rate work by Delran Builders and, of course, the wonderful final result.
